II. At Shabd, hosted by Mahadevi Birla World Academy, RPPS students shined brightly among 17 schools, winning 1st positions in Intellectra, Runway and Movie Review and 2nd positions in Melodia and Reverberance.

IV. VIII. Competing against 18 schools at Jyotishk 1.0, hosted by Jyotirmoy Public School, RPPS secured top position in solo dance.



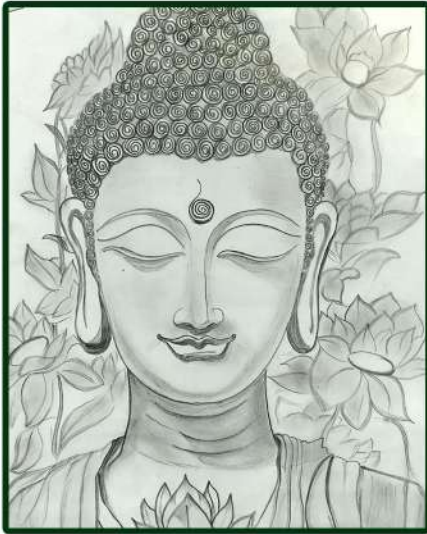

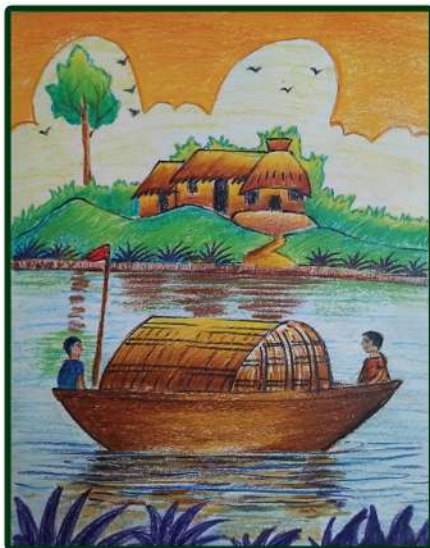

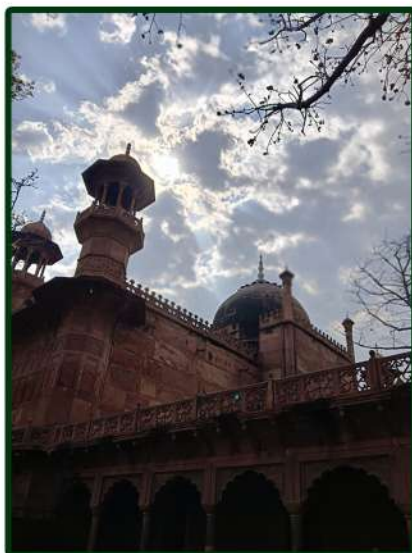
